The survey, conducted in November 2022, involved 239 site respondents from Europe (47%), Americas (27%), Asia (20%), and the Middle East & Africa (6%). These respondents held various roles and conducted research across multiple therapeutic areas. The survey was co-developed with a group of worldwide site experts.
